# Overview: Funding possibilities for academic staff at FUB to go abroad

- **Partnership funding**

Under the umbrella of the partnerships with international universities (30 universities: reimbursement of flight and visa costs)

- **Stays abroad for academic staff**

Defrayal of travel and accommodation costs arising from research and teaching stays of up to six weeks at international universities.

- **Research Alumni Program**

Short stays abroad for young scientists to study (abroad) with former FU guest researchers.

- **University Alliance for Sustainability**

Stays abroad at Freie Universität's Strategic Partner Universities for research and teaching in the field of "sustainability."

- **Erasmus+**

Short teaching stays (1-2 weeks) at partner institutions in Europe and selected institutions around the world.

# Erasmus+ Mobility for Teaching Procedures / Application and Documents

Applications can be handed in **at all times**. The following documents are necessary:

## 1. For the application:

- Mobility Agreement
- Bank account details

## 2. Before departure:

- If applicable: Request for Authorisation of a Business Trip

## 3. After the mobility:

- Confirmation of the partner institution
- Travelling documents to confirm the period of travelling
- Report about the teaching mobility within the „Mobility Tool“

# Mobility Grants I

The mobility grants consist of unit costs for travel and stay as prescribed by the EU:

## Calculation of travel costs:

Distance (according to the distance calculator of EU KOM)	Amount (round trip)
< 100 km	-
100 - 499 km	180 €
500 - 1.999 km	275 €
2.000 - 2.999 km	360 €
3.000 - 3.999 km	530 €
4.000 - 7.999 km	820 €
> 8.000 km	1.100 €

# Mobility Grants II

## Calculation of the costs for the stay:

Country of destination	Amount (up until day 14)	Amount (from day 15 onward)
Denmark, Ireland, Netherlands, Sweden, United Kingdom	160 €	112 €
Belgium, Bulgaria, Finland, France, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, Austria, Poland, Romania, Czech Republic, Turkey, Hungary, Cyprus	140 €	98 €
<b>Germany</b> , Latvia, Malta, Macedonia (FYROM), Portugal, Slovakia, Spain	120 €	84 €
Estonia, Croatia, Lithuania, Slovenia	100 €	70€

Mailing to all departmental Erasmus+ coordinators at the beginning of funding period (July)

>Presentation within departmental committees

>special presentations to interested groups

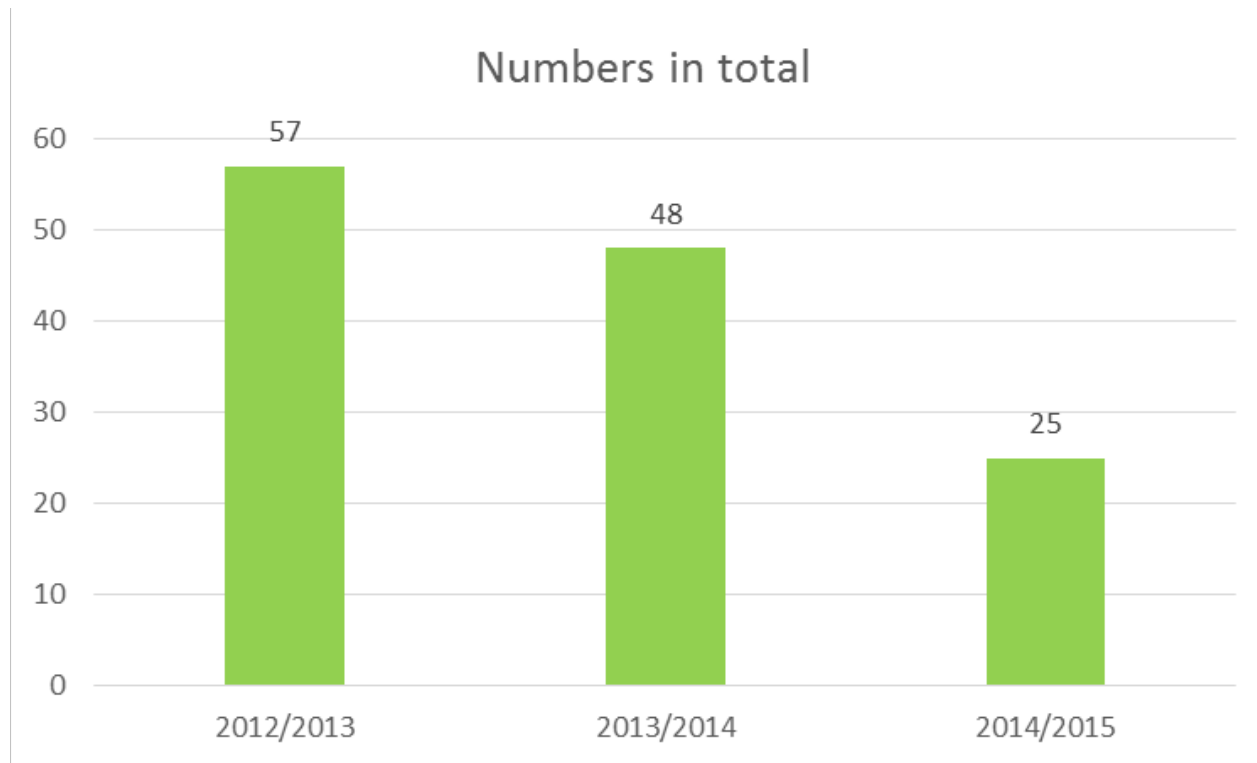
# Erasmus+ Staff Mobility for Teaching

## Priorities for Funding (applicable in case of lack of funds)

- Funding for 1 week, justified cases: 2 weeks
- Mobilities that strengthen and help the establishment of relationships between departments, serve the preparation of future cooperation projects, or ameliorate the Erasmus+ student exchange numbers
- Staff who has not participated in an Erasmus+ teaching staff exchange yet
- Mobilities that take place for the first time with a respective partner institution
- Staff who has already received funding the year before but visited a different institution

- Past Performance: Numbers in total



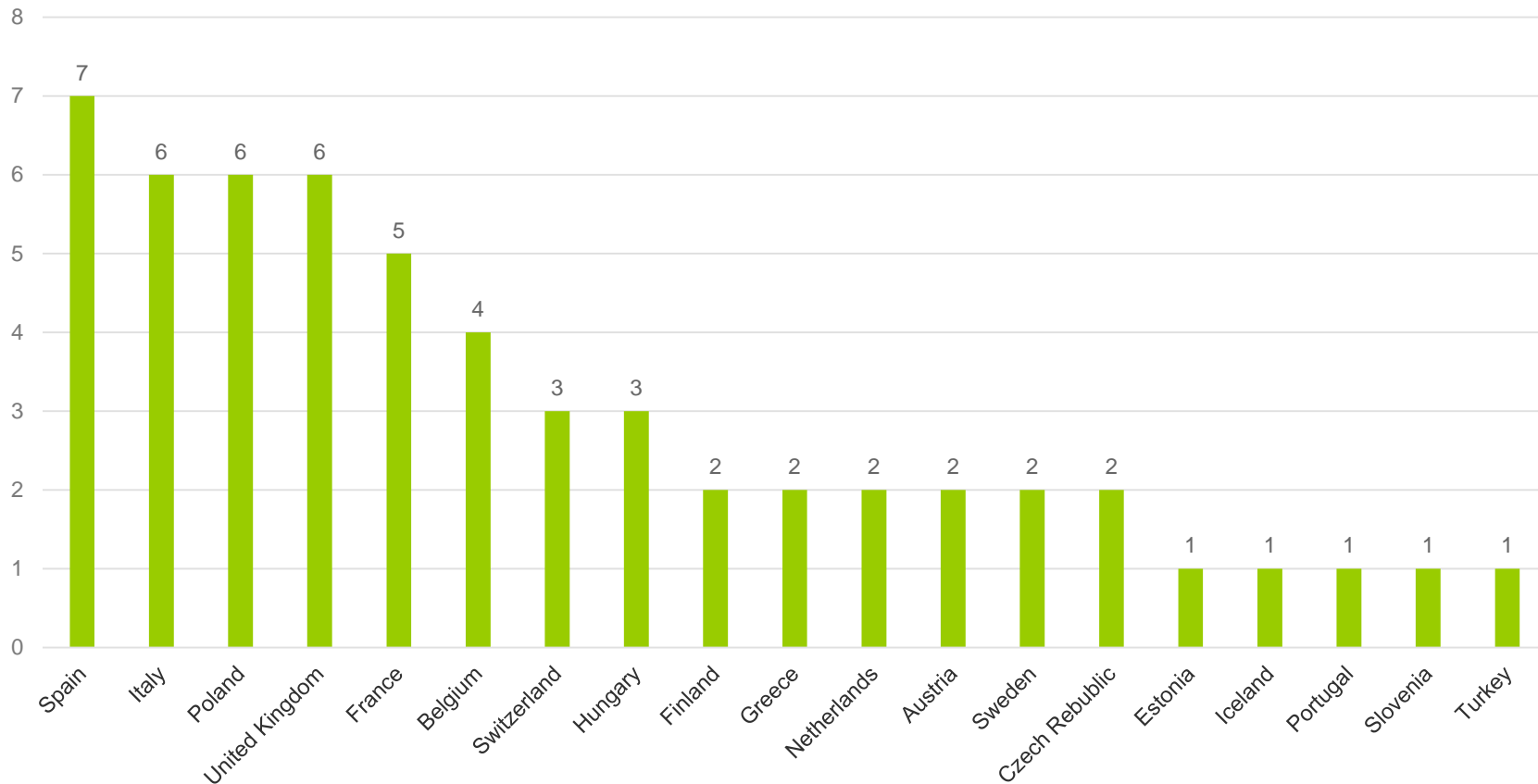
Total number of spots according to contracts 2016/2017: **736**

- Past Performance: According to countries of destination

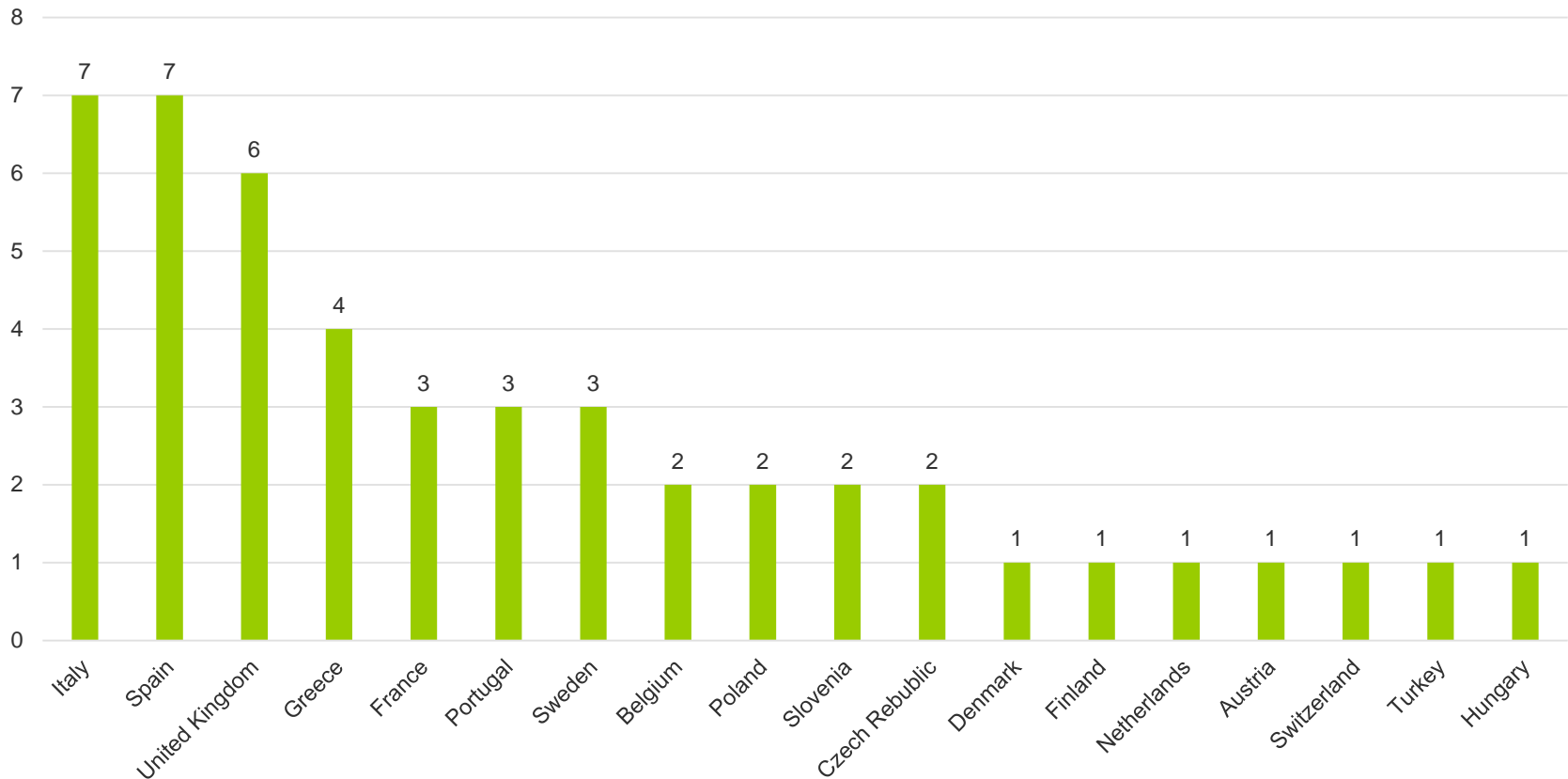
2012/2013

- Past Performance: According to countries of destination

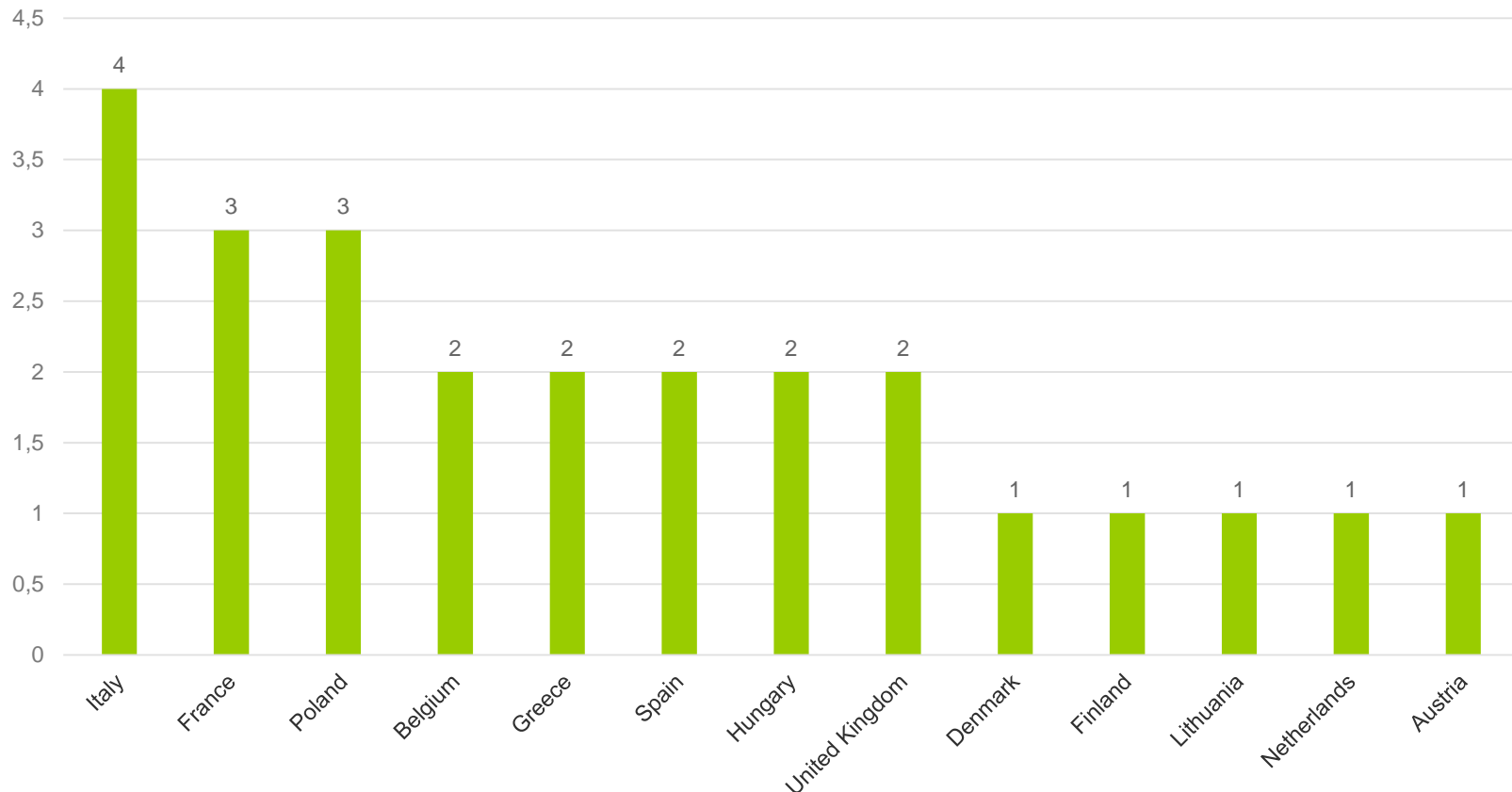
2013/2014

- Past Performance: According to countries of destination

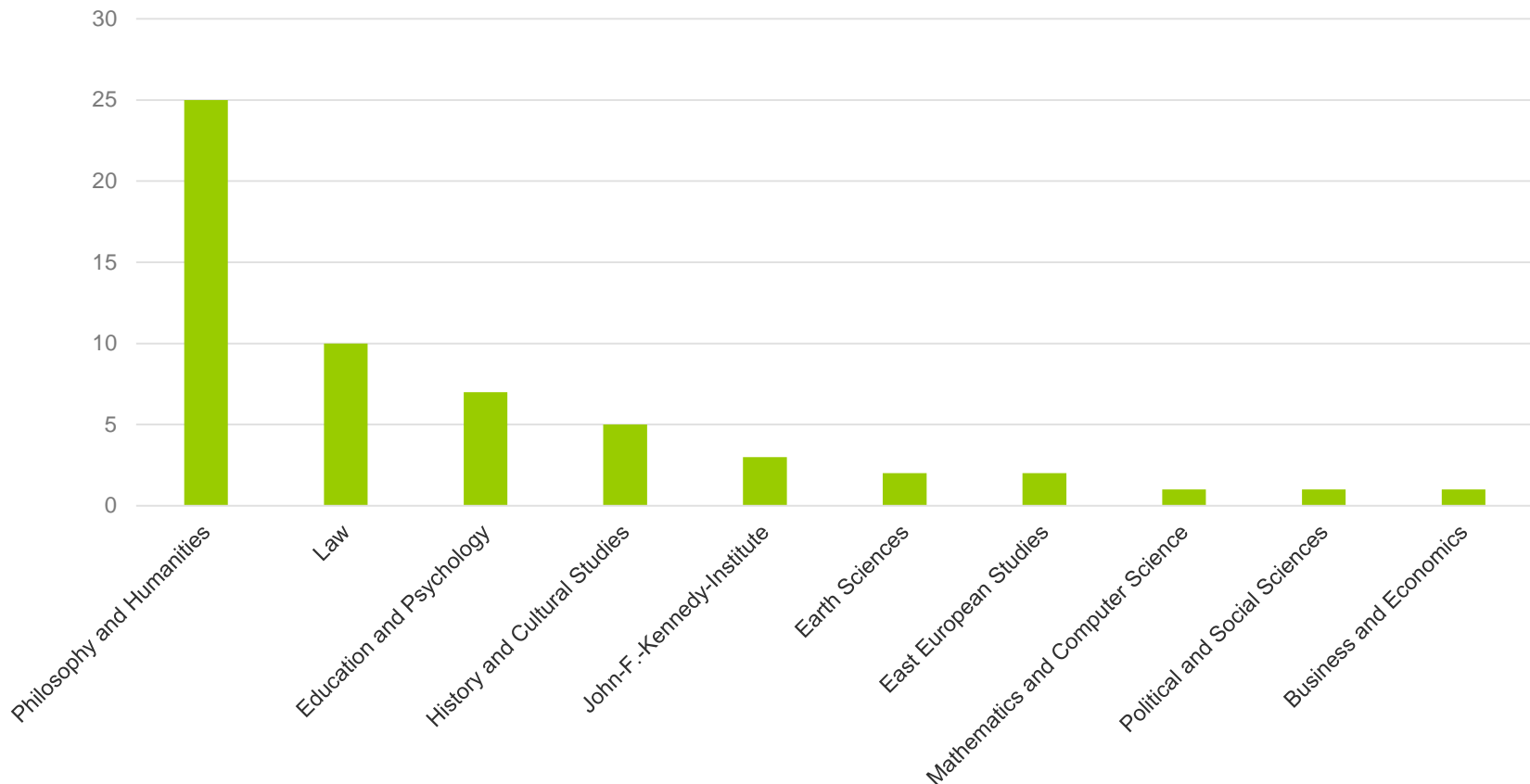
2014/2015

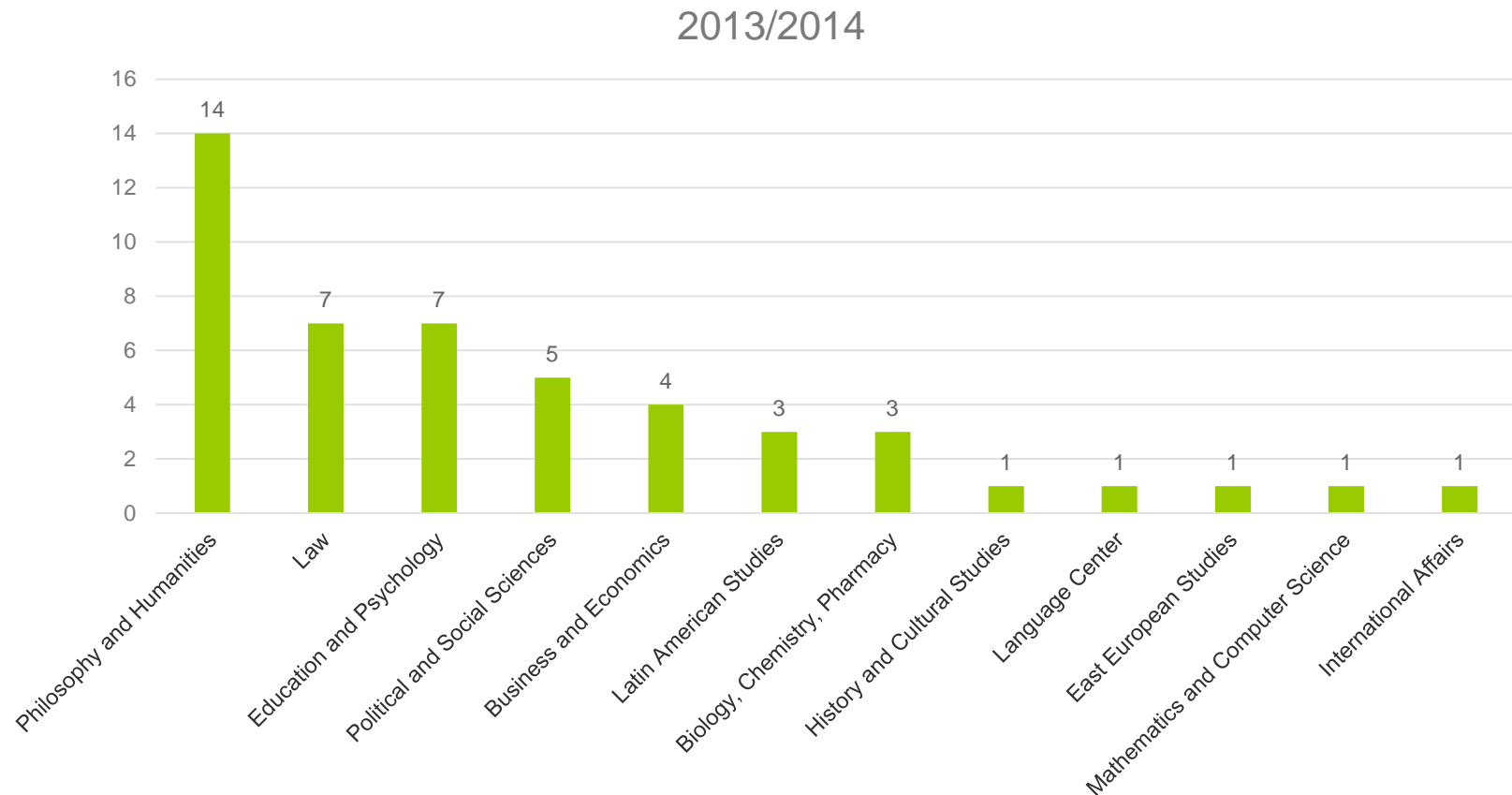
- Past Performance: According to departments at FUB

2012/2013



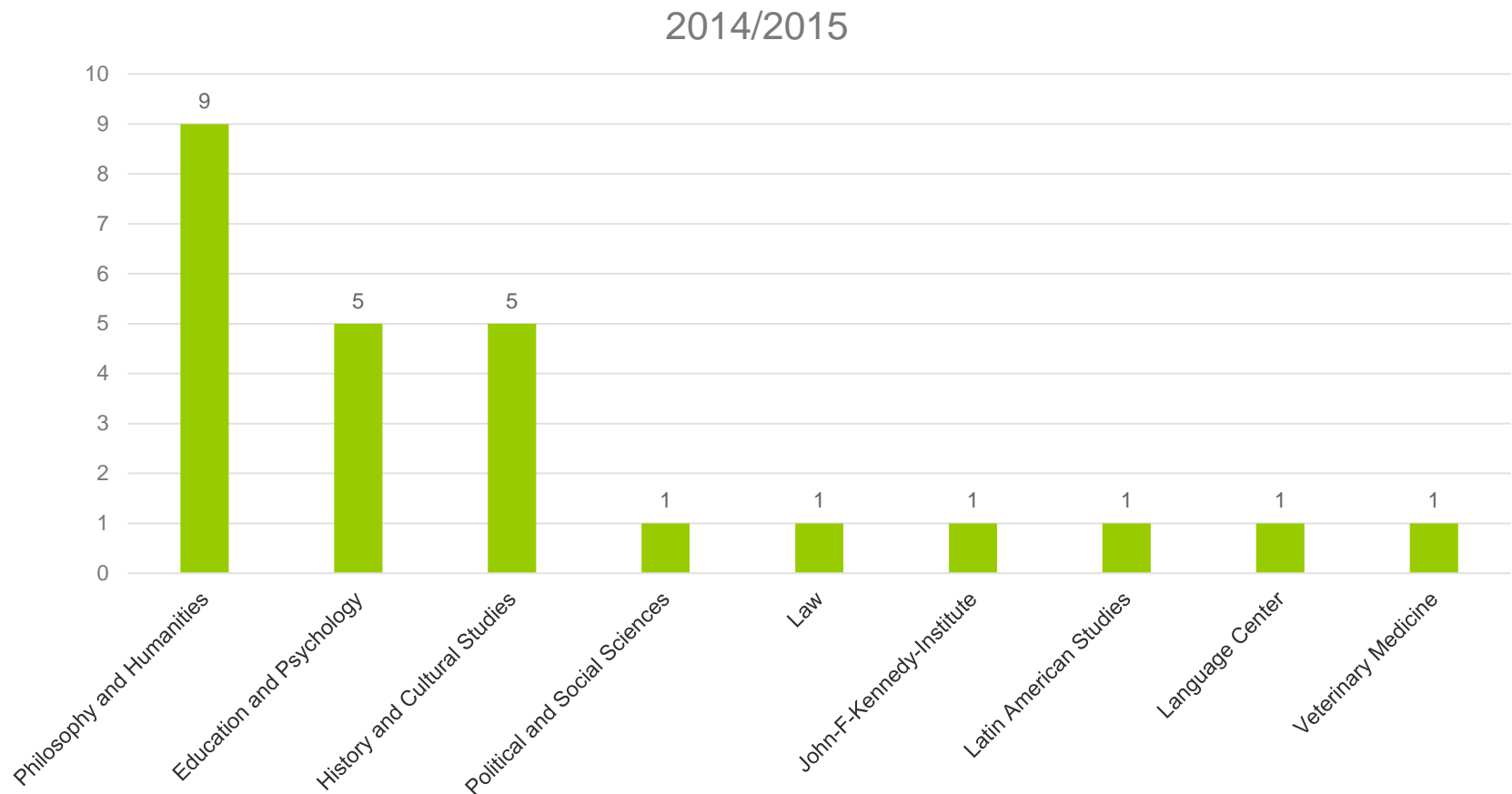
