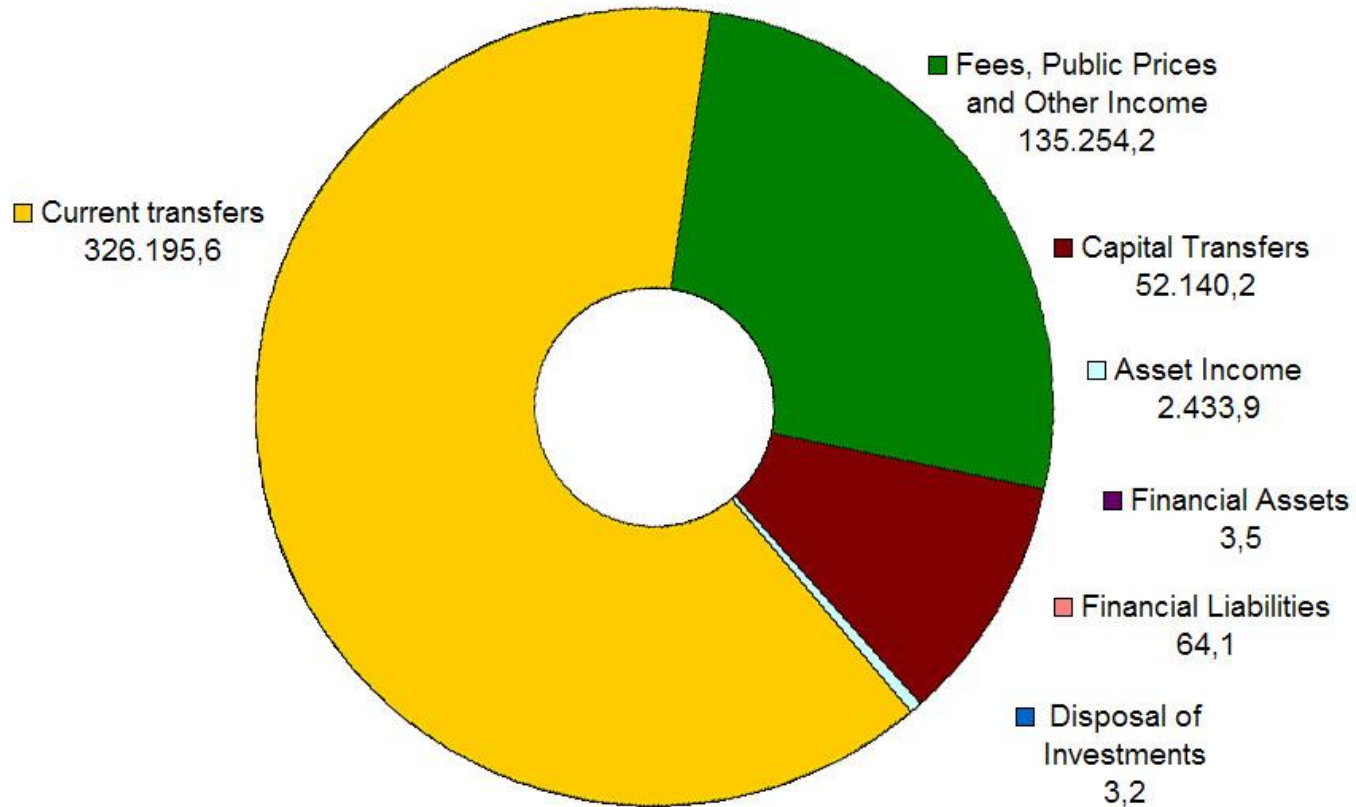

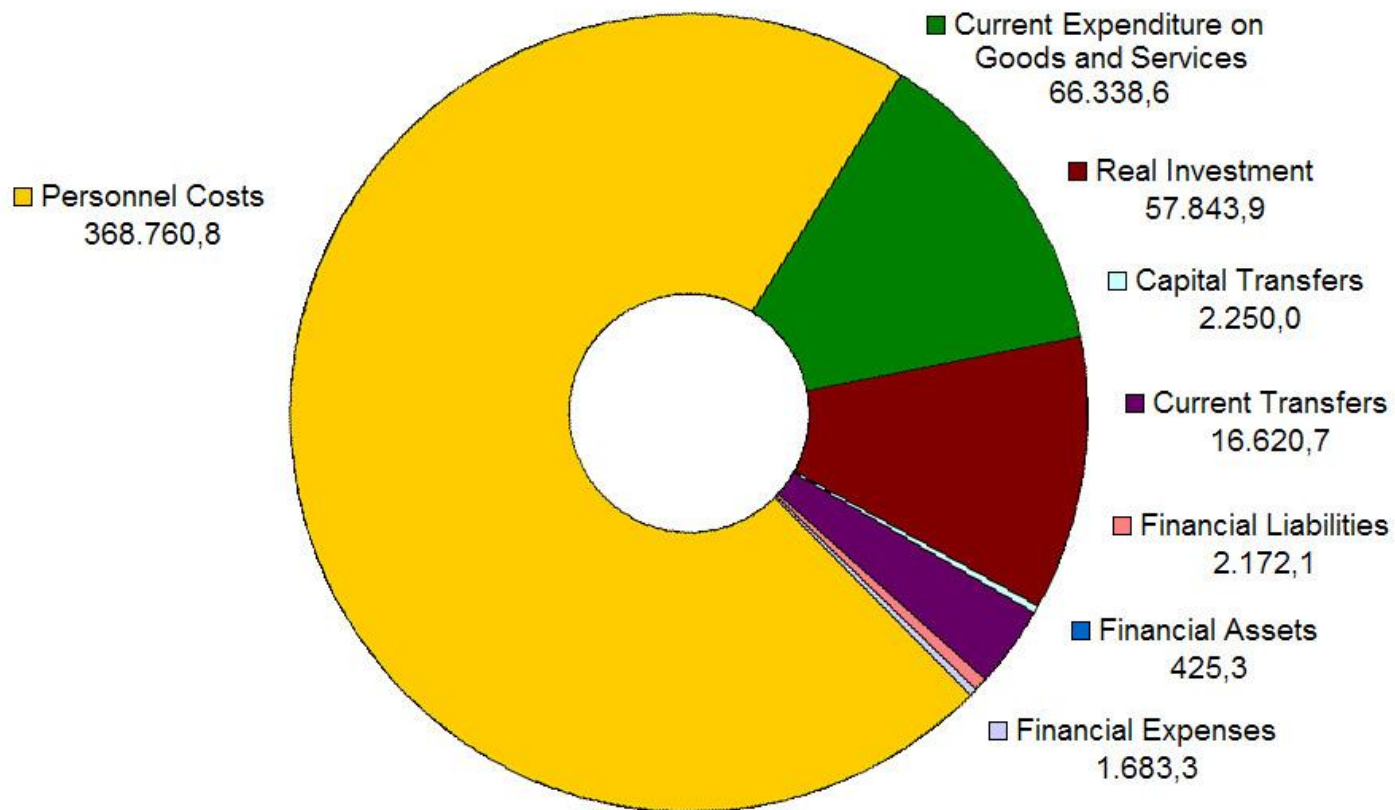
Operating Revenue
