<u>Project title:</u> Constraint-based modelling of metabolic networks

Project description:

The goal of the project is to develop new mathematical methods and efficient algorithms for modeling metabolic networks and their regulation. The student should have a strong background in mathematical modeling and optimization, especially using discrete and constraint-based methods. In addition, basic knowledge of molecular biology and biochemistry is required.

Language requirements:

The daily research work and the thesis can be done in English.

Academic requirements:

Master degree in Mathematics, Computer Science or Bioinformatics, with specialization in an area relevant to the project.
