Project description:

The project takes into focus recent archaeological discoveries in Turfan and Hami areas of the Autonomous Region of Uyghur Xinjiang. Applicants should be very familiar with excavation results in both areas as well as in Gansu and Qinghai provinces. The PhD project provides opportunities to study publications from neighboring regions such as Tadzhikistan and Uzbekistan for a comprehensive comparative research approach.

Language requirements:

The doctoral thesis can be written in German or in English language. In any case German language proficiency is required.

Academic requirements:

Suitable subject areas: Archaeology, Art History, Central Asian Studies; BA degree is not sufficient for a full time doctorate.
