### **CALL FOR CONTRIBUTIONS**

The 5<sup>th</sup> UNICA Green Academic Footprint Workshop will address the topic of “Sustainability at Universities – How to Combine Management and Participation?”. Key questions addressed within this context are: How to combine management processes and the need of participation in the field of sustainability? How to successfully apply participation methods? How to engage internal and external stakeholders in higher education institutions?

The UGAF workshop shall serve as a platform to share experiences on the topic. To this end we invite submissions for a poster session on good participation activities in the following areas:

- Sustainable Campus Management
- Education for Sustainable Development
- Involvement of Stakeholders at All Levels of the University

In a first step we ask you to send a short description (1–3 pages) about your activities, which should include pioneering experiences or successful systematic approaches. In a second step all selected contributors will be asked to present their project in a poster session during the UGAF-Workshop.

Each activity or project should address the following questions:

- What were the goals and greatest challenges? How did you cope with them?
- What were the key obstacles and key success factors for your project/initiative?
- What are the lessons learned? Which key aspects should be considered in similar activities?
