



CALL FOR APPLICATION (2015) FOR MA AND PHD STUDENTS FROM FREIE UNIVERSITAET BERLIN

Thanks to a DAAD-grant, the *Dahlem Humanities Center* of Freie Universitaet Berlin has established the Thematic Network *Principles of Cultural Dynamics* (PCD). We are pleased to announce **5 Global Humanities Junior Fellowships** for MA and PhD students from Freie Universitaet, working on questions related to the network's topic. Fellows will be able to conduct research at one of the PCD network's partner institutions for **four to six** months:

1. **Harvard University, Mahindra Humanities Center**
2. **The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Faculty of Humanities**
3. **The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Research Institute for the Humanities**
4. **The Johns Hopkins University, Humanities Center**
5. **École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales (EHESS), Paris.**

Fellows are obliged to participate in the PCD network's *Global Humanities Campus*, which consists of a two-week summer school and a workshop, and which will be taking place in Berlin in the summer (July 20 – August 2, 2015). Fellows may schedule their research stays abroad at a time of their choosing in 2015, so long as they are able to fulfill their mandatory participation in the *Global Humanities Campus*.

Fellows will receive a lump sum for travel purposes, as well as a monthly subsidy toward accommodation expenses, both administered by the PCD-network. The PCD-network will also assist fellows in preparing their stay.

In case they decide to apply, applicants should be prepared to submit the following documents electronically:

1. CV
2. Outline of their research project not to exceed one page
3. Personal statement (2-3 pages), detailing their scholarly interest in the partner institution of their choice; the link between their research project and the network's theme of cultural dynamics; as well as the time of their intended stay
4. A copy of their latest degree
5. Proof (e.g. in the form of an email exchange) that the professor with whom the applicant wishes to work at the partner institution ('mentor') is willing to supervise the applicant during his or her research stay
