

Information for Applicants



Applicants are entitled to apply for additional funding along with the funding provided via the basis module (please refer to Information Sheet B for further information) if they are planning to apply for ERC Starting/Consolidator/Advanced or Synergy Grants. The costs for these measures are borne centrally by Division VI: Research and are not offset against the amount covered by the application. The funding applies to the following:

- Applicants with a W2/W3 professorship are eligible for a **reduction in their teaching workload** amounting to two teaching hours during the semester of the submission deadline.¹ The applicant must submit their request for a reduction in teaching hours through the official channels set in place by their department and the Personnel Division. Division VI: Research can provide central resources to finance the hiring of a substitute lecturer if the request is approved.
- Participating in a (one-day) **proposal writing workshop** with an external consulting agency; usually at least 4 months before the submission deadline.
- Workshops/courses on grant writing in the form of extensive, written feedback on the application draft by an external consulting agency and a feedback session at least four weeks before the submission deadline.
- Interview training to prepare for the second stage of evaluation.
