16:00	<p>Official International Week Lecture: “The Limits of Internationalization” (70 years FU Berlin Anniversary) <i>Prof. Joybrato Mukherjee (Vice President – German Academic Exchange Service)</i></p> <p>Prof. Dr. Joybrato Mukherjee (born 1973) has served as President of Justus Liebig University Giessen (JLU) since 2009 and as Vice President of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) since 2012. After earning a PhD in English linguistics in 2000 and completing his Habilitation in 2003 at the University of Bonn, Prof. Mukherjee became Professor of English Linguistics at JLU in the summer of 2003.
