



Una Europa is a European University Alliance consisting of 11 universities that has set itself the goal of intensifying cooperation in the areas of research, teaching and outreach. Besides Freie Universität Berlin, the members of this university alliance are Università di Bologna, University College Dublin, University of Edinburgh, Universiteit Leiden, KU Leuven, Universidad Complutense de Madrid, Uniwersytet Jagielloński in Krakow, Helsingin Yliopisto (University of Helsinki), Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne and the University of Zurich.

Una Europa Research Exploration Funds Deadline: Applications can be continuously submitted Maximum grant sum: 2.000 €

Who can apply for funding?

University lecturers (professors, private lecturers, junior research group leaders)

What is the amount of funding?

Maximum 2.000 euros.

What kind of activity is funded?

This call welcomes university lecturers and professors of FU Berlin to apply for a short stay at one of the Una Europa partner universities. This short stay can be used in order to identify the possibility of longer personal research stays and potential for further collaboration with the partner universities. This information can then be disseminated at FU Berlin.

A project funded by our Una Europa Research Exploration Funds can be the basis for an application to our Una Europa Starter/Consolidator Funds with a larger delegation from FU Berlin, or a workshop for a joint application.





What can be funded?

- Costs for travelling to and accommodation at one of the Una Europa partner universities. In accordance with DAAD guidelines, actual costs must be calculated; lump sums are not possible.
- Persons who receive funding are responsible for the entire organisation of their stay (travel, stay, insurance, etc.). The Una Europa team can provide support in making contact with the partner institution.

Application documents:

- Online application form,
- Other attachments if necessary to describe your project.

Applications can be continuously submitted and will be awarded on the basis of the availability of third-party funds and after review by a selection committee. Due to limited funds, there is no guarantee of funding.
