We are looking for research from various disciplines with focus and/or interest in sustainability research.

Your task is limited to the supervision of one student at a time that is collecting data in your research team for his master thesis and your research project. He will be officially supervised from his/her home university.

What you have to do is:

- Before (e.g. in case of Erasmus+ funding) sign an official document before his/her research stay/internship and talk to the student and the official supervisor if the topic and student fits to your research team.
- During (e.g. in case of lab work) include him into your team, supervise his/her activities in the lab.
- After: keep contact with student until he/she is finished with the thesis to use the data for your research and/or start joint projects with the research team of her/his research team/supervisor at the home university.
