“Ion Creanga” State Pedagogical University of Chisinau

- “Ion Creanga” State Pedagogical University was founded according to the Decision of Moldovan SSR on August 23, 1940, being initially called Pedagogical Institute and consisting of five faculties: *the Faculty of History and Philology, the Faculty of Physics, the Faculty of Mathematics, the Faculty of Biology, the Faculty of Geography.*
- The academic staff of the institute consisted of experienced professors and researchers from university centers of Iasi, Moscow, Rome, Kyiv, Warsaw, Saint Petersburg etc. In the post-war period, the Doctoral Section which was training specialists in Philology, History, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Botany, Zoology, Anatomy was founded within the institution.
- Since 1945, the University has considerably expanded the school teachers’ training profile.



ICSPU Structure

- At the moment, the University consists of five faculties:
- *The Faculty of Philology and History;*
- *The Faculty of Psychology and Special Psycho-Pedagogy;*
- *The Faculty of Education Sciences and Computer Science;*
- *The Faculty of Fine Arts and Design;*
- *The Faculty of Foreign Languages and Literatures.*
- *These faculties train teachers for more than 60 de specialities.*



ICSPU Structure

- The Centre of Continuous Development of Teaching and Management Staff, founded in 1975, became a republican center of continuous training of teaching staff and of professional management training of administrative staff from pre-university education.
- Within the 16 departments of the University, 12 university professors, 9 Habilitated Doctors, 124 Doctors of Science, 104 Associate Professors are employed. At the University faculties, more than 4000 students are enrolled, from which 2207 at 1st cycle, 902 – at 2nd cycle and more than 300 – at 3rd cycle of study. By now, the Pedagogical University has trained more than 40000 teaching staff, more than one hundred of which have been awarded the title of Honorary Teacher of the Republic.






Future Classroom



- The National Center of Digital Innovations in Education “Future Classroom” is a platform of digital innovations in education which ensures rethinking of the way in which modern technologies transform the educational process and their implementation in the educational system.
- Here we train new generations of competitive and professional young people with progressive thinking, who will assure durable growth of the country’s economy.
- Established on April 19, 2019, the Center is located within “Ion Creangă” State Pedagogical University, which festivity hall was renewed and refurnished, that offers a flexible and reconfigurable space, inspired from the principles of the Future Classroom and endowed with educational digital equipment such as SMART interactive screens, robotics kits, VR glasses, panoramic cameras, a total of 30 types of educational technologies.

Future Classroom



- Yearly, approximately 1000 academic staff are trained to apply new technologies in school. Future Classroom Center hosts important events for teachers and allows visits for pupils, testing digital equipment and their replication in all the schools from the country.
- The National Center of Digital Innovations in Education “Future Classroom” is the strategic nucleus for the entire educational system and a platform for didactic training and counselling for schools. At the same time, the Center develops thematic training programs based on the use of digital applications and tools in the teaching-learning-assessment process, including in-class and remote communication between teacher and student. These programs are used while training teachers at national level.
- The Center’s vision is perfectly harmonized with professional training policies and strategies developed and implemented within “Ion Creangă” State Pedagogical University, but also with University’s vision regarding didactic activity and the development of the educational system from the country.
- Future Classroom has been realizing a public-private partnership (PPP) between Republic of Moldova Government, Competitiveness Project of Moldova funded by USAID, Swedish Government, UK aid and Orange Moldova Foundation. Implementation partners of the project are “Ion Creangă” State Pedagogical University, State University of Tiraspol and University Information Center.
