PhD Project description:

The PhD project will focus on the analysis of emotional repertoires circulating globally via Reality TV. The project will be part of a complex research cooperation (SFB "Affective Societies") focusing the constitutive relevance of emotions and affect for societies. Empirically global formats of Reality TV (e.g. Top Model) will be analyzed in a comparative design to identify cultural similarities and differences of the performative rules to display emotions in popular media formats.
