<u>Project title:</u>	Affective and aesthetic processes in poetry and prose reception: a comparative neurocognitive study in Chinese and German

Project description:

A recent neurocognitive poetics model of literary reading (Jacobs, 2015) will be tested experimentally with behavioral and neuroimaging methods in both the Chinese (Mandarin) and German language. The focus will be on the stylistic foregrounding devices used in both languages to obtain special aesthetic effects and their neuronal correlates.

Language requirements:

The doctoral thesis will be cumulative (based on 3-4 publications) and in English. Proficiency in German is not required but very helpful.

Academic requirements:

M.Sc. in experimental psychology or cognitive neuroscience.
