Project title:

Dissertation on Middle Iranian or Old Turkish texts and their contents

Project description:

Various aspects of the history, of linguistic history or of the religions (Buddhism, Manichaeism, Christianity) represented in the texts from the Silk Road in north-western China can be chosen according to the individual interests of the student.

Language requirements:

The dissertation can be written in English. Supervision will be in English. It is also expected that the student will attain at least a reading knowledge of German during his stay in Germany (i.e. knowledge of German is a not a precondition for the application or admittance).

Academic requirements:

For a full doctorate at the Free University Berlin the student needs to have completed a Master's degree (or equivalent) in the history or on some aspect of the linguistic or religious history of the Silk Road. If instruction in additional pre-modern languages is required for the topic of the dissertation this will be provided, if possible during a preliminary period before the work on the dissertation begins.

For the sandwich programm, admission to the doctoral programm of the student's home university in China will suffice. Here too, if instruction in pre-modern languages is required for the topic of the dissertation this will be provided.
