#### Initial situation

- The department utilises an "isolated application" for the administration of Diplom study programs
- In the WiSe 06/07, the department introduced two new Bachelor study programs
- Specific exception rules exist for statutes governing general examination matters (SfAP)
- Prelimininary research showed that most requirements, of the department, were already covered by processes defined in SAP CM through other departments
- The additional requirements of the department are to be systematically ascertained and documented
- The department was represented, from the start of the FU project "Campus Management", by a "Keyuser"



## Project goals

- Introduction of SAP CM by the Department of Business & Economics, commencing with the WiSe 06/07 for the Bachelor study programs "business economics" und "economics" in the first semester (currently no non-department interchange to advanced semester)
- Controlled transfer from project status to online usage
- Achieve acceptance throughout the department for the new application SAP CM
- Utilisation of SAP CM by all employees of the Administration Studies office and registrar's office as well as the lecturers and their representatives



## Project overview


- Analysis and evaluation, with respect to the change requirements of the department, for current FU academic processes, forms and reporting
- Development of new processes and adaption of existing processes in accordance with the requirements of the department
- Define the specific requirements of the department, with respect to SAP CM (requirements catalogue)
- Bring about a decision concerning the scope and content of the requirements catalogue
- Handover the requirements catalogue to the project team "Campus Management"
- Clarify, determine and schedule, with the project management of "Campus Management", the to be realised requirements
- Plan and realise the "Rollout" of the core software "Campus Management" (SAP CM) by the department



# Project results

- For the Department Business & Economics, production began according to schedule in the WiSe 06/07
- The employees in administration have been trained and are productively using SAP CM
- The lecturers have been informed and trained
- In the first semester, 384 new students have registered for modules, lectures and examinations in the Bachelor study programs
- The supplementary requirements catalogue was completed and authorized by the department before being handed over to the CM project management
- The input of examination results, by the lecturers resp. their representatives, was performed at the end of the WiSe 06/07
- The additional requested functions will be provided step by step, in accordance to their requirement

- Bring about a common understanding for the project
- Realize the rollout of software is an organizing project
- Integrate all participants who are involved, within the department, with academic processes
- Define and determine responsibilities
