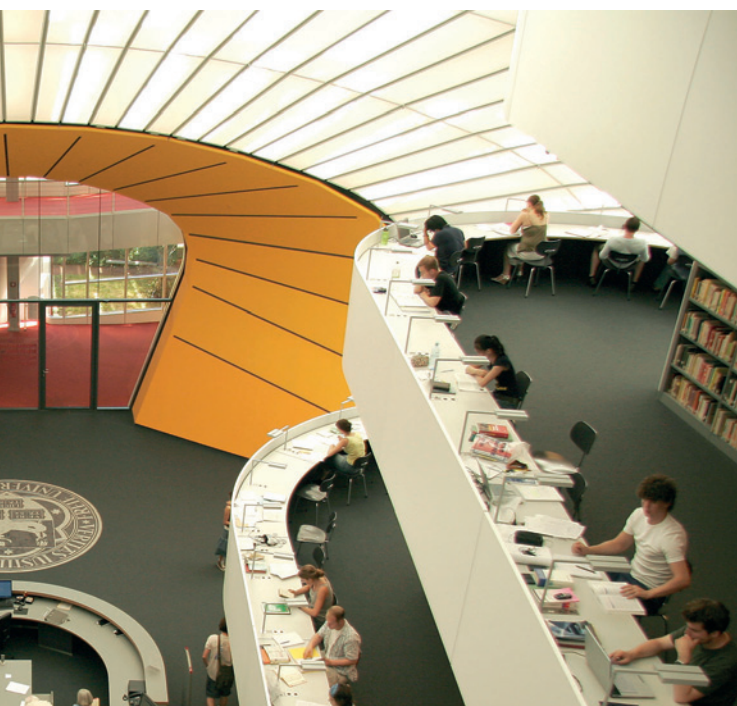


What are Focus Areas?

What are Excellence Programs?

The German excellence initiative aims at the promotion of outstanding research projects and graduate schools at German universities. Freie Universität Berlin has been one of the most successful universities in the second phase of the competition with 10 Excellence Programs: 3 Research Clusters and 7 Graduate Schools have been awarded funding for another five years (2012 to 2017).

The program enables promising junior researchers to

- work independently on a research topic of their own choice
- further develop their scientific expertise in an effective, targeted way
- establish themselves in their field of research, e.g., by publishing on the topic
- start new co-operations in a stimulating research environment
