



## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR POSTDOCTORAL SCHOLARS FROM FREIE UNIVERSITÄT BERLIN

Due to the aid of a DAAD-grant, the *Dahlem Humanities Center* of Freie Universität Berlin has established the Thematic Network *Principles of Cultural Dynamics* (PCD) and is pleased to announce:

### 5 Global Humanities Junior Research and Teaching Stays

for postdoctoral scholars from Freie Universität Berlin, working on questions related to the network's topic. These fellowships will enable Fellows to conduct research at one of the PCD network's partner institutions for **three to five** months:

- **Harvard University, Mahindra Humanities Center**
- **The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Faculty of Humanities**
- **The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Research Institute for the Humanities**
- **The Johns Hopkins University, Humanities Center**
- **École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales (EHESS), Paris.**

Fellows are obliged to teach one session at the PCD network's *Global Humanities Campus*, consisting of a two-week summer school and a workshop taking place in Berlin in the summer (July 25 – August 7, 2016). They may schedule their research stays at a time of their choosing, so long as they are able to fulfill their mandatory participation in the *Global Humanities Campus*. Fellows will receive a lump sum for travel purposes, as well as a subsidy toward accommodation expenses, both administered by the PCD-network. The PCD-network will also assist fellows in preparing their stay.

Applicants should be prepared to submit the following documents for consideration:

1. CV
2. Personal statement (2-3 pages), describing their research project and its links to the network's theme of cultural dynamics
3. Dates of their intended stay abroad
4. A copy of their doctoral degree
5. Proof (e.g. in the form of an email exchange) that applicants have established contact with researchers at the partner institution with whom they wish to cooperate
