
mission

The University Alliance for Sustainability combines the strengths of five strategic partner universities to develop joint research and teaching projects on the topic of sustainability. We offer exchange options for students, faculty members and administrative staff from across faculties and the universities to promote sustainability discourse throughout whole institutions.

- > St. Petersburg State University, Russia
- > University of British Columbia, Canada

To reach the goals of the University Alliance for Sustainability, we introduce the following activities:

Annual Sustainability Spring Campus in Berlin

- > Public Events: keynotes by renowned experts
- 3-day Research Incubators: to develop or work on joint research projects
- > 3-day Management Incubator: sustainable campus management workshop
- 6-day Sustainability Springboard: intensive training for up to four doctoral students from each university

Teaching Incubators, 2015 and 2017

- 3-day meeting of academics in charge of teaching activities from relevant partners' departments at Freie Universität Berlin
- Identification of suitable degree programs and individual modules for cooperation

Management Incubators, 2015 and 2017

- > One week workshop at Freie Universität Berlin
- Management staff shares best practice in sustainable campus management and develops joint projects

Who: 2 outgoing and 2 incoming students per year

> Sustainability Volunteer Swap, 2015 – 2018 Exchange between student initiatives at the partner universities.

Who: 5 persons engaged in student initiatives at FUB

> Administrators' Explorative Stays, 2015 – 2018
Alternating exchanges for campus managers.

Who: 2 administrators to Freie Universität Berlin (2015+2017) / 2 administrators to partners (2016+2018)
