*The Security Council,*

*Guided by* the goal of the nuclear weapon-free world,

*Reaffirming* the crucial importance of the national sovereignty of every nation,

*Supporting* international equality in terms of use of nuclear energy for exclusively civil purposes,

*Recalling* the SC Resolution 1803 (2008) and 1835 (2008),

1. *Calls upon* the Iranian authorities to comply with their duty to report on all nuclear activities to the IAEA under the NPT;
2. *Commits* all Member States to establish an independent expert group in order to
  - a. develop an operational plan to logistically ensure the supply of enriched material for the peaceful use of nuclear energy for Iran,
  - b. technically assist the Iran with its programme concerning the peaceful use of nuclear energy, especially finishing the construction of a nuclear power plant,
  - c. work on establishing an international fuel bank with access by any nation, to secure reliable energy supplies for all, and therefore reducing the risk of proliferation;
3. *Designates* a timeframe for point 1 – 60 days;
4. *Approves* the implementation of further sanctions should Iran fail to comply with its obligations after the exhaustion of the timeframe mentioned in point 3, which will include:
  - a. maintaining the already existing sanctions,
  - b. introducing diplomatic measures against Iranian officials, including travel bans,
  - c. freezing international bank accounts,
  - d. limiting international transport (humanitarian and medical issues excluded);
5. *Affirms* its intention to remain seized of the matter.
