First Ordinance on the Amendment of the Admissions Regulations for the Master's Degree Program M.Sc. Mathematics within the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Freie Universität Berlin

Preamble

On the basis of Section 14.1.2 of the supplemental rules and regulations (Teilgrundordnung [Erprobungsmodell]) of Freie Universität Berlin of October 27, 1998 (FU-Mitteilungen 24/1998) in conjunction with Section 10a of the Law on Admissions to Higher Education in the Federal State of Berlin for Programs with Admission Requirements Hochschulzulassungsgesetz - BerlHZG), in the version of the announcement of the amended version from June 18, 2005 (GVBI. p. 393), last amended on May 20, 2011 (GVBI. p. 194) in conjunction with Section 10.5.2 of the Berlin Higher Education Act (Berliner Hochschulgesetz - BerlHG) in the version of the announcement of the amended version from July 26, 2011 (GVBI. p. 378), the Department Council (Fachbereichsrat) of the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Freie Universität Berlin issued the following First Ordinance on the Amendment of the Admissions Regulations for the Master's Degree Program M.Sc. Mathematics, originally published on June 13, 2012 (FU-Mitteilungen 61/2012, p. 1022), on June 19, 2013:*

Section I Section 2.3 is amended as follows:

"The application deadline each year is January 15 for the following summer semester and May 31 for the following winter semester."

Section II

This ordinance shall enter into force on the day following its publication in *FU-Mitteilungen* (the official bulletin of Freie Universität Berlin).
