The report should have a length of **3 to 4 pages (DIN A4 format)**. Feel free to add photos, but please take care not to exceed the file size limit of 8 MB.

Consider writing about the following:

Preparation

Planning your mobility, reason for choosing the host country/partner institution, organization, applying at your home university as well as to the partner university, language preparation

Accommodation

Recommendations on how to find an accommodation (Student dorms, private housing), support by the partner university, rent and further costs

Studying at the Partner University

language requirements and language of instruction, trimester/semester dates, course selection, exams, level of difficulty, learning/teaching methods in comparison to FU/Charité, recommendations concerning your field of study, support by the partner university, orientation-/buddy-programme, location of the university, university facilities, success concerning accreditation of courses at FU/Charité

Skills and Learning Achievements

Development of your skills in terms of academic, social, language or intercultural aspects, expected gain for your academic and professional future

Everyday Life and Leisure

Sports activities, language courses, student groups, social integration, cultural and regional activities, public transportation, quality of life

Additional Costs/ Financing Your Stay (optional)

Recommendations on where to obtain information, applying for scholarships, living expenses, costs compared to life in Germany, further recommendations (Shopping, getting around etc.)



Intercultural Experience/ Experiencing Europe

How did your preconceptions about other cultures or about Europe change? Did some turn out to be true? Similarities/differences between the local culture and that of your own country and situations, which you perceived as challenging

After completing your study abroad, do you see yourself more as a European citizen than before? Why? During your mobility, did you notice ways in which the EU has an impact on your studies (EU research grants, EU-projects, laws/guidelines of the EU etc.)?

Other

For example, essential things to bring from Germany when going abroad, things you would have liked to know before you started your mobility

Conclusion

For example, the most positive and the most negative aspects of your mobility

Please consider that we will not edit your report in any way. If you do not want certain personal data or information to be published, then please do not mention these in your report in the first place.
